Feed-A-Need Food Assistance Program

If you are experiencing temporary food insecurity (*i.e. can't afford to eat and/or do not have access to food within a given period of time*), you are encouraged to apply to the Feed-A-Need program. This program provides you with up to 14 free meals a semester which can be used anytime within the semester you have been approved to receive free meals. To qualify for this program, you must:

- Be a full-time enrollment in a BFA program;
- Be able to demonstrate need i.e. disclosing on your Feed-A-Need application your current situation and why you temporarily do not have access to food.
- Complete an in-person interview with the Associate or Assistant Dean of Student Affairs.

If you are interested in applying, complete the following [online application](#). Your application will be processed within 48 hours. Once you are approved for food assistance, the College will place the meals electronically onto your One Card for the purchase of meals on-campus in *Elaine's*. Please note, meals can only be used during the meal hours posted in *Elaine's*. You may also use them in the Café only if and when *Elaine's* is closed during a particular meal block. Just ask for a meal exchange.
